

Putley Parish Council Meeting

Minutes of the meeting held in Putley Parish Hall
on Thursday 15th February 2018

1. To receive Declarations of Interest:
There were no declarations of interest.
2. Public Participation and Ward Members Report:
 1. The tree warden gave a very informative talk on Ash dieback, a fungal disease spread through spores, and how it would affect the landscape.
 2. The Ward Member updated Council on the budget increase for the next financial year (4.9%), and explained that 76% of the budget is spent on social care for vulnerable adults and children. The route for next part of the bypass is being considered and is out for public consultation. £8 million has been recovered from Amey, the majority will be spent on the roads.

Councillor Herbst summarised notes from the meeting on 25th January and subsequent meeting between Mrs Herbst, Mrs Fenton and Karla Johnson from Herefordshire Council, who felt that the boundaries are too tight to allow for the number of houses required. The next meeting will address this issue.

Councillor Denman requested that the criteria-based part of the plan be looked at and tightened up.

The current funding expires at the end of March; however, it is hoped that any underspend can be reapplied for.
